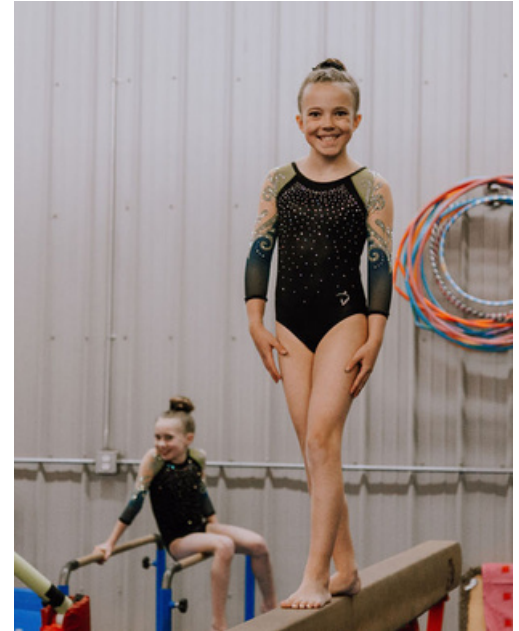
COMPETITIVE UPDATE
